**Mission Statement:** Teaching the camping experience through Christian values and ideals.

**Activities:** Horseback riding, climbing & rappelling, ropes courses, swimming (lake and pool), canoeing, water skiing, basketball, soccer, lacrosse, tennis, archery, riflery, crafts, hiking, mountain boarding, volleyball, cheerleading, guitar, golf, baseball and mountain biking.

**Interview:** The director will arrange an interview with the applicant after the application and all reference forms are received.

**Lodging:** Built in 1994, all cabins are screened and have ceiling fans and complete bathrooms. Generally, there are 10 campers with two or three counselors in each cabin.

**Reference Forms:** Each applicant must have three forms completed by the adult references listed on the application.

**Ropes Ranger Training:** This week of training certifies instructors in the high adventure elements to include climbing, rappelling and ropes courses. During this week rangers will also assist in preparing the camp and programs for the summer. This is a paid week. Please indicate on the application if you have an interest in this training week.

**Lifeguard Training:** American Red Cross Lifeguard certification offered at no charge to staff.

**Salary:** Base salary is \$185.00 a week. Salary includes room and board plus performance bonus and travel allowance and varies according to job responsibilities. Each counselor receives a minimum of one hour of free time daily plus one night off during the two-week sessions. The Friday and Saturday between sessions is also considered time off.

**Transportation:** All staff must provide their own transportation both to and from camp.

**Orientation:** Required attendance. This is a paid week for counselors. During orientation, each staff member will be certified in American Red Cross First Aid and CPR for the Professional Rescuer.

Lifeguard certification is offered to those interested during the Ropes Ranger week. There is no charge for the certification courses.
