Activities: Horseback riding, climbing & rappelling, ropes courses, swimming (lake and pool), canoeing, water skiing, basketball, soccer, lacrosse, tennis, archery, riflery, crafts, hiking, mountain boarding, volleyball, cheerleading, guitar, golf, baseball and mountain biking.

Lodging: Built in 1994, all cabins are screened and have ceiling fans and complete bathrooms. Generally, there are 10 campers with two or three counselors in each cabin.

Application: Applicants should apply online. If necessary, an application may be downloaded and printed.

Reference Forms: Each applicant must have three forms completed by the adult references listed on the application.

Interview: The director will arrange an interview with the applicant after the application and all reference forms are received. Most of the interviews are held in February.

Salary: For first year CITs, pay is \$50 per week plus room and board. Second year CITs receive \$75 per week plus room and board.

Sessions: CITs generally work one session and not the session attended as a camper. First year CITs may work only one session. Second year CITs may apply to work two sessions. Please list all available sessions you could work to increase your chances of being hired. Generally, CITs report to camp the Friday prior to session opening by 11:00 AM. They depart by 10:00 AM on the session closing day.

Training: There will be a daily class for CITs during the camp session. There will be a mandatory training session held in Memphis TN in the spring for those who live in the area.

Transportation: All staff must provide their own transportation both to and from camp.
